

HIGH SCHOOL IDOL 7 RULES

Eligibility: You must be a legal U.S. resident, 14 to 18 years old by March 2012 and enrolled in a Sarasota County High School. If you are less than 18 years of age, you must provide a release form signed by your parent or guardian. You must be enrolled as a student for the 2011 school year. You are ineligible if you already have graduated from high school. You are also ineligible if a member of your family or household is employed at The Education Channel.

Paperwork: You will be required to fill out, sign and agree to all of the terms and conditions in our required forms. These forms are available on line on our website at www.TheEdChannel.net under High School Idol- Rules and Regulations. We will need the Release Form sent to us at 4748 Beneva Rd. Sarasota FL 34233.

The Process: Submit your audition to facebook and/or YouTube

The First Audition: Make sure you have filled out all paperwork and sent it to us either by mail, submitting on line or emailing to leanne_mcintire@Sarasota.k12.fl.us.

Then, videotape your self singing a cappella. You may use whatever device you have access to, such as your phone, to record your audition.

Then, using the link to facebook from our website home page- www.TheEdChannel.net, upload your audition video to our facebook page.

We also have a YouTube channel, which you can subscribe to where we will share the videos and you may also be able to share your audition.

Videos can be submitted from February 1 through March 31, 2012. Any submission after March 31 will be ineligible.

Videos can be NO LONGER than 3 minutes. Anything longer will be disqualified. SO it does not have to be an entire song- just part of a song. You may submit up to 2 videos of yourself.

The judges will then review all submissions and choose FIVE FINALISTS. We will notify the winners by the middle of April.

Final Audition: The 5 finalists will perform at the Players Theater on May 21 at 6 PM. Contestants will perform two songs with pre-recorded music either from the Producer's list or from a CD of their own. Tickets will be sold and contestants will perform before a live audience and judges

will choose first, second and third place winners.

NO WEAPONS, ALCOHOL OR NON-PRESCRIPTION CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES WILL BE PERMITTED AT ANY AUDITION OR DURING THE COMPETITION.

CONTESTANTS CANNOT WEAR ANY CLOTHING ITEMS BEARING DESIGNER OR SPORTS LOGOS OR BEARING THE NAME OR LIKENESS OF A CELEBRITY, LIVING OR DEAD TO ANY OF THE AUDITIONS OR FINAL PERFORMANCES. CONTESTANTS CAN BE DISQUALIFIED FOR INAPPROPRIATE DRESS AS DETERMINED BY THE PRODUCER SUCH AS TOO SHORT SKIRTS/DRESSES, TOO MUCH EXPOSED SKIN, INAPPROPRIATE SAYINGS OR SYMBOLS ON ANY APPAREL. INAPPROPRIATE LYRICS AND BODY MOVEMENTS WILL ALSO BE CAUSE FOR DISQUALIFYING.

Disqualifications: We reserve the right to disqualify and/or exclude, in our sole and absolute discretion, any individual from any of the auditions for any reason, including without limitation, violation of any portion of these rules, or tampering with the entry process or the audition process. We also reserve the right to change the rules and procedures at any time. Being chosen to audition and/or compete at any level in the process does NOT ensure that you will be selected to continue to the next stage.

GENERAL CONDITIONS: By participating, entrants agree to be bound by these rules and the decisions of the producers, the voting audience, and the panel of judges, which shall be final and binding. We reserve the right to use the auditioning process for publicity and other purposes, and to use the name and likeness of those who audition and who arrive to audition, including friends, family or any other individual accompanying the participant, as part of that publicity and for other purposes, without compensation unless prohibited by law. All federal, state and local laws apply. Dates are subject to change. Sarasota County Public School District, The Education Channel, www.theeducationchannel.net and the production personnel for the television program, participating television stations, advertising agencies or any person or entity connected with the production, administration or judging of the auditions or the program, or any of their respective parent companies, affiliates, subsidiaries, agents or representatives are not responsible for and shall not be liable for: (i) any failure of transportation, bad directions, or inability for any reason to appear at an audition site or audition or appear before the judging panels; (ii) any injuries, losses or damages of any kind caused by participating in the auditioning process or being selected to or disqualified from continuing in the auditioning process and/or the show; or (iii) any printing, typographical or technological errors in any materials associated with the auditioning process.
